5.2 Access

The SERVICE PARK is designated as a Low Density Area (LDA)

Access will be restricted to other Officials of the event and accredited service crew members only

5.3 Service Area

The competitor is obliged to service only within the allocated service areas.

All crews are also obliged to use a liquid-proof tarp under competition cars.

It is MANDATORY for each crew to have FIRE EXTINGUISHERS at their service areas.

Each Competitor is liable for the damages to the Service area allocated to them.

The crews are responsible for removal of their WASTE and LITTER.

After the rally, the Service Park has to be handed over in tidy condition.

5.4 Maximum Speed

Maximum speed inside the Service Park is limited to **15 km/h**

These above Service Park regulations will be controlled by the Service Park Manager and any other officials present. Failure to comply with the above regulations will result in a financial penalty applied by the Clerk of the Course.

6. FUEL / TYRES

6.1 FUEL

6.1.1 The use of FIA approved Race Fuel, commercial pump fuel and AVGAS are permitted.

- All competitors who require AVGAS from Puma Tanzania must place the fuel order & pay by 14th July

6.1.2 Competitors are solely responsible for providing and distributing their own fuel during the event.

6.1.3 All refueling will be carried out in designated refueling zones outside the service parks during the allocated liaison section times.

6.2 TYRES

6.2.1 Tyres, quantities specified for use during the rally

Refer to article 13 of FIA Regional Rally Regulations.6

6.2.2 Tyres for use on reconnaissance

Free Tyres for gravel.

6.2.3 National laws or special requirements

Other than on special stages all National Traffic laws will apply.

7. IMPORTS OF VEHICLES & SPARE PARTS

7.1 Vehicle Registration and Licensing

Vehicles temporarily imported into Tanzania are not required to be registered, provided they are re-exported before the expiry of the Carnet de Passage, the Insurance Bond or the time limit for validity of the cash deposit.

If you are temporarily importing your car from a PTA country, you need to obtain a 'COMESA YELLOW CARD' from your local insurance agent. This will enable you to drive your car in Tanzania for a specified period of time.

PTA Countries – Angola, Botswana, Burundi, Djibouti, Eritrea, Ethiopia, Lesotho, Mozambique, Namibia, Rwanda, Somalia, South Africa, Sudan, Swaziland, Tanzania, Uganda, Zaire, Zambia, Zimbabwe.

7.2 Vehicle Parts and Importation

All vehicles and spare parts, temporarily imported into Tanzania, must be guaranteed against import duty and taxes (except Kenya and Uganda – see below). There are three ways in which this can be done.

i) AIT/FIA Carnet de Passage

This document allows the temporary importation of a vehicle and any spare parts declared on related documents. It guarantees the payment of import duties and taxes on the vehicle or spares parts, should you not re-export them.

It is the most convenient way of temporarily importing a vehicle and spare parts. The original carnet and related documents must be presented to Customs at the port of entry and again at the port of exit. The Carnet de Passage is obtainable from your local ASN.

ii) Insurance Bond

This involves the execution of a customs bond with an insurance company.

The Commissioner of Customs calculates the duty and taxes payable on the vehicle and spare parts.

The importer pays a percentage of the duty and taxes payable, as a premium, to an insurance company, who thus becomes the guarantor.

The original bond must be presented to Customs at the port of exit, where it will be cancelled on re-exportation of the vehicle and spare parts.

iii) Cash Deposit

This involves the deposit of an amount of money, equivalent to the import duty and taxes payable on the vehicle and spare parts, which is refundable on re-exportation of the vehicle and spare parts. This method is not only very expensive, but also very time consuming.

7.3 Imports from Kenya and Uganda

You need to obtain a letter from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, permitting temporary export, of a vehicle and spare parts, to Tanzania. When crossing the border you need to submit your Log book to the Tanzanian border post.

You need to re-export your car within a week, from the same border post, in order to collect your logbook. Intervals more than a week are subject to a charge upwards of US \$ 50.00

11. RECONNAISSANCE

11.1 Procedure for Registration

Reconnaissance registration will take place at Rally HQ at the same time as Administrative Checks on Wednesday, 21 July 2021 from 14:00 – 18:00

11.2 Time Schedule for Reconnaissance

Reconnaissance will be held according to the schedule specified in Appendix 2 of these Supplementary Regulations. The schedule of Reconnaissance must be fully respected by crews.

11.3 Reconnaissance Rules and Special Restrictions

11.3.1 General

Reconnaissance will be organized in compliance with Art.35 of FIA RRSR.

11.3.2 Reconnaissance cars

Reconnaissance cars allowed in accordance with Art.35.1 of FIA RRSR.

Reconnaissance cars must have the insurance policy according to Tanzanian Traffic Law regulations.

The Organiser accepts no responsibility on this matter.

More than one crew may share a car during reconnaissance.

11.3.3 Identification Numbers

The Reconnaissance number supplied during registration must be affixed onto the Reconnaissance car on the top of the front windscreen (Co-driver's side).

It must be visible for the duration of the Reconnaissance period.

11.3.4 Number of passes

Competitors are permitted only ONE (1) pass over each special stage during Reconnaissance.

All stages driven more than once in the rally will be considered as one stage for Reconnaissance purposes.

11.3.5 Driving Direction

Under no circumstances may competitors drive in the opposite direction of the rally traffic. Competitors may only enter a special stage through the start and exit through the finish. The special stages will be open for normal use during Reconnaissance, therefore safety and rights of other users must be respected.

11.3.6 Reconnaissance Control Card

Reconnaissance Control Card will be issued to the crews at registration and must be carried in the car for the duration of the Reconnaissance.

This card will be signed appropriately recording every run on each special stage.

Failure to produce this card will result in refusal to participate in the Reconnaissance.

Reconnaissance Control Card must be returned after the completion of Reconnaissance.

11.3.7. Illegal Reconnaissance

Any member of the crew taking part or intending to take part in the rally who is found on the route of any special stage outside of the listed Reconnaissance dates and times will be deemed to be performing illegal Reconnaissance.

Any infringement will be reported to the Stewards.

11.3.8 Speed limits

Competitors must fully respect the Tanzanian Traffic Law regulations, including use of seatbelts and speed limits. *The maximum speed allowed on special stages during reconnaissance is 80 km/h.*

12. SCRUTINEERING, SEALING & MARKING

12.2 Mud flaps

Transversal mud flaps are mandatory under these Supplementary Regulations and must comply with FIA ISC Appendix J Art 252.7.7

12.3 Windows / Nets

In accordance with FIA ISC Appendix J Article 253.11

12.4 Drivers Safety Equipment

At Scrutineering competitors must produce all items of protective clothing, underwear, helmets and a FIA approved head restraint (FHR) intended to be used.

Compliance with FIA ISC Appendix L Chapter III will be checked.

12.5 Noise Levels

Noise level may be checked.

The maximum noise level admitted is 94dB (A) to 103dB (A) as per FIA ISC Appendix J Article 252.3.6

12.6 Special National Requirements

All Left Hand Drive Vehicles must display a LHD sticker on rear left of the vehicle

12.7 Installation of Safety Tracking devices

- All cars must be fitted with the safety tracking system provided by the Organiser.
- Competitors must make provision in their cars (brackets correctly secured) for the installation of a Safety Tracking System. Operating instructions will be given during installation.
- The correct functioning and installation of the equipment will be checked at scrutineering and any competing car without properly functioning unit will not be authorized to start the rally.
- Each crew is materially responsible for the safety tracking system installed in their car.
- Crews are instructed to arrive at scrutineering THIRTY (30) minutes earlier than their allocated scrutineering time to allow for the installation of the Safety Tracking device.

Any car reporting late for tracking device installation shall incur a penalty of TZS 50,000/-

12.8 Final Scrutineering

Will take place immediately after the Rally Finish at Highland Estates Ltd.

13 Free Practice / QUALIFYING Stage

Venue - Highland Estates Ltd, Ubena

Date - Saturday, 24TH July 2021 at 08:00

All competitors to report at qualifying stage holding area latest by 07:30.

13.1 General

- A free practice/qualifying stage will be organized for all competitors in order to establish the rally start order for Day 1
- The results of the Qualify Stage will only be used to establish the Start Order for Leg 1 and will not form part of the rally results.
- All competitors, who passed Administrative Checks and Scrutineering, must participate in the Qualifying Stage.
- It is compulsory to wear the safety equipment of driver and co-driver as for normal rally Special Stage.

13.2 Running of Free Practice

A Free Practice stage will be organised with the purpose of being both a media and promotional opportunity and for competitors to trial their cars. The drivers may complete a maximum of 2 passages of practice within the timeframe specified by the organisers.

13.3 Breakdown during Free Practice

A competitor whose car is unable to complete the Free Practice stage will be required to wait for the organisers to transport the car to the end of the stage after the Free Practice session has finished.

13.4 Disclaimer

Any passenger on board the car during Free Practice who is not entered for the rally is NOT permitted.

13.5 Running of the QUALIFYING Stage

After the 2 passages allowed for practice, all drivers will start the Qualifying stage in the order of the current African Rally Championship for Drivers with a 2-minute interval between each car.

The driver and co-driver entered must be on board the car throughout the Qualifying stage.

The Stewards shall decide the order of drivers who are not been classified in the African Rally Championship for Drivers.

In the event of a dead heat in Qualifying, the competitors concerned will be classified in the order of their start positions in the Qualifying Stage.

13.6 Non – participation or breakdown during QUALIFYING Stage

- Any car which breaks down during the Qualifying stage or during the following road section will be transported to the parc fermé by the organisers once the Qualifying stage has finished.
- Any ARC eligible driver who does not participate or does not correctly complete the Qualifying stage will be seeded last on the start list, amongst the ARC eligible drivers.
- All other non-ARC eligible driver who does not participate or start at the scheduled time or does not correctly complete the Qualifying Stage will be seeded in the Start List for Leg 1 as determined by the Clerk of the Course.
- If more than one driver does not complete the stage, start positions will be chosen in the order of the starting list for the Qualifying stage.

13.7 Attribution of Starting Positions

- ARC Eligible competitors (TOP 5 FASTEST ONLY) will choose their start position for the rally according to the results of the Qualifying stage. The fastest driver will choose his position first, then the second, followed by the third etc. Any driver who did not arrive on time to choose his position will automatically choose his position last.
- All other Non-ARC eligible competitors following the ARC Starting Order will be determined according to the qualifying stage results and upon discretion of the Clerk of the Course.

13.8 Late or early Check-In

Any late or early check-in to the time control preceding the start of the Qualifying stage (TCQS) will be considered as an incorrect participation and Art. 37.6.2 of V2 – FIA African Rally Championship, under the 2021 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations

13.9 False Start

Any false start during the Qualifying stage, particularly one made before the signal has been given, will be considered as an incorrect participation and Art. 37.6.2 of V2 – FIA African Rally Championship, under the 2021 FIA Regional Rally Sporting Regulations

13.10 Service

From the beginning of the timetable for Free Practice until the individual start time of the Qualifying stage, service may only be carried out in the main service park or the service park designated by the organiser for this purpose.

13.11 Technical Requirements

For applicable cars, the engine, the complete transmission and the mechanical parts mentioned in the Regional Rally Championship's Sporting Regulations must be sealed.

14. START PROCEDURES

14.1 Ceremonial Start

The Ceremonial Start will take place at Southern Sun in Dar es Salaam on Friday 23rd at 16:00.

- All competitors to report at ceremonial start holding area latest by 15:00.
- It is **COMPULSORY** for all crews **TO ATTEND IN RACING OVERALLS**
- Where a crew in its competing car is unable to participate in the ceremonial start, it shall be permitted to start the remainder of the rally at its allocated start time provided that the Stewards are notified and subject to passing the necessary scrutineering checks. 19. LIST OF USEFUL FACTS & SERVICES

Facts about Tanzania

- Climate:** Daytime temperatures are normally around 30 degrees (Centigrade) and the nights are cooler.
- Health** Due to the large prevalence of malaria in Tanzania, visitors are advised to begin anti-malaria prophylaxis a week before arriving in the country and continue for four weeks after they've left. Very efficient private hospital care, clinics, chemists, air rescue services etc. are available in Tanzania.
- Immigration** All visitors are required to have a valid passport. Information as to whether Visas are required should be sought from the nearest Tanzanian Consular services.
- Language** English and Kiswahili are the languages widely spoken.
- Security** Tanzania is relatively safe however its recommended to avoid isolated places and walking anywhere alone after 19:00 Hrs.
- Time Zone** Tanzania is 3 hours ahead of Greenwich Meridian Time (GMT + 3).
- Transport** Taxis are easily available and should be used where possible. Uber is also available in Dar es Salaam
- Voltage** Tanzania's electricity grid is 220 – 240 volts AC
- Driving** Driving in Tanzania is on the left side of the road. Consequently, most cars are right hand drive. Overtaking is only on the right side Please give way to pedestrians on the zebra crossings. Drive safely by observing traffic signs, speed limits and by wearing safety belts. Talking on a mobile phone (without a hands free gadget) while driving is a serious offence. All residential, business and industrial areas and areas having streetlights (built up areas), have a speed limit of 50kph. In some areas, road signs indicate varying speed limits. Elsewhere, the speed limit is 80kph. It is an offence to drink and drive in Tanzania, and if caught, a stiff fine or imprisonment can result. Beware of potholes and broken roadsides. Vehicles may come onto your side of the road while over-taking or avoiding a pothole: Most accidents involve buses, lorries, mini buses, dala dalas and three-wheelers. There are emergency breakdown services available in most places in Tanzania Beware of roadside mechanics if your car does break down Traffic regulations are enforced very strictly in Tanzania

20. TRAVEL ADVISORY (COVID-19)

Information on entering Tanzania

The current regulations for entering Tanzania released by the Ministry of Health have the following requirements as per 'Travel Advisory No 7 of 4th May 2021'.

Further details are available at <http://www.moh.go.tz/en/announcements>.

- All travelers are required to present a negative COVID-19 test certificate upon arrival. The test must be a Real Time Polymerase Chain Reaction test (RT-PCR), with the sample collected within 72 hours before arrival in Tanzania. Travelers in transit more than 72 hours will be re-tested by rapid test upon arrival in Tanzania. The rapid test cost is USD \$25 per traveler.
- Travelers are required to complete an online Health Surveillance Form available at <http://afyamsafiri.moh.go.tz/> within 24 hours prior to arrival. Travelers will then receive a Unique Health Code (UHC), which they will present to health officials upon arrival.
- All travelers entering Tanzania will be subject to enhanced screening for COVID-19, including through a rapid test. The rapid test cost is USD \$25 per traveler.
- All travelers arriving from India or having traveled through India in the last 14 days will be subjected to a rapid test at the Point of Entry followed by 14 Days mandatory quarantine at their own cost.
- Travelers subject to mandatory quarantine shall choose a place from the list designated by the Tanzanian government, which is available at airports.
- Returning residents from India will be allowed to quarantine in their homes under strict surveillance system.



Precautionary measures while in Tanzania

It is **MANDATORY** to wear face masks/shields in public

Also the Organizers of the event highly recommend the implication of all personal safety precautions during the event including

- Social Distancing – maintain at least 2 metres distance from each other
- Practice Hand washing hygiene/sanitizing
- Avoid shaking hands and physical contact with other personnel

Information on departing Tanzania

All travelers must check individually on the requirements of the destination country respectively when traveling back from Tanzania.

For countries that require COVID-19 Test certificates, sample collections can be done and tested through Government of Tanzania laboratories.

In order to book a COVID-19 test the following procedures are applied,

- You must fill an online COVID-19 test application form available on the Ministry of Health website at <http://pimacovid.moh.go.tz/#/booking>.
- The costs of the test vary between USD \$100 - \$200 depending on the facility used for the sample collection.
- The results of the test are made available between 48-72 hours of the sample collection.
- A text message will be received with a link to your COVID-19 certificate when your results are ready.






